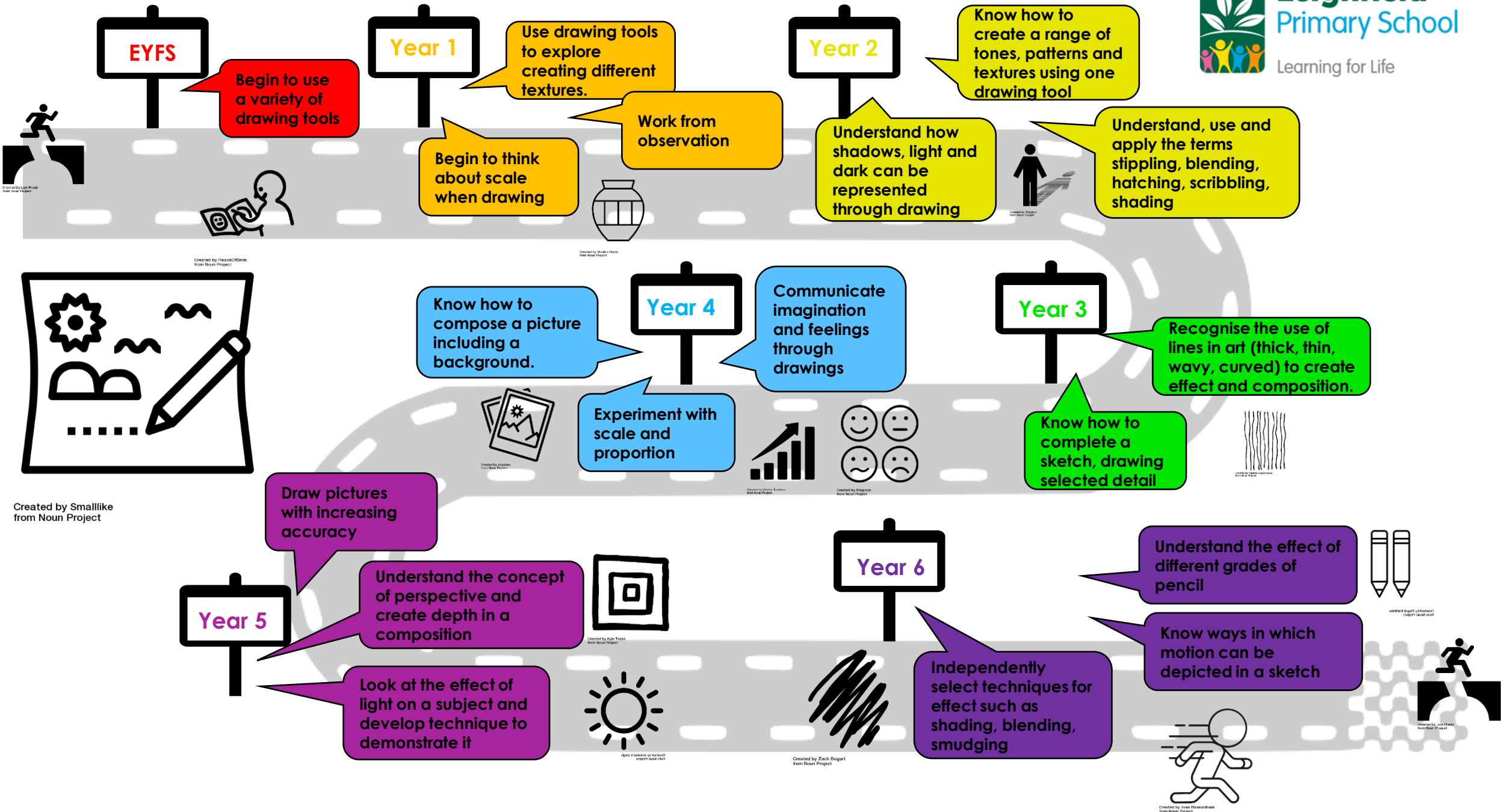
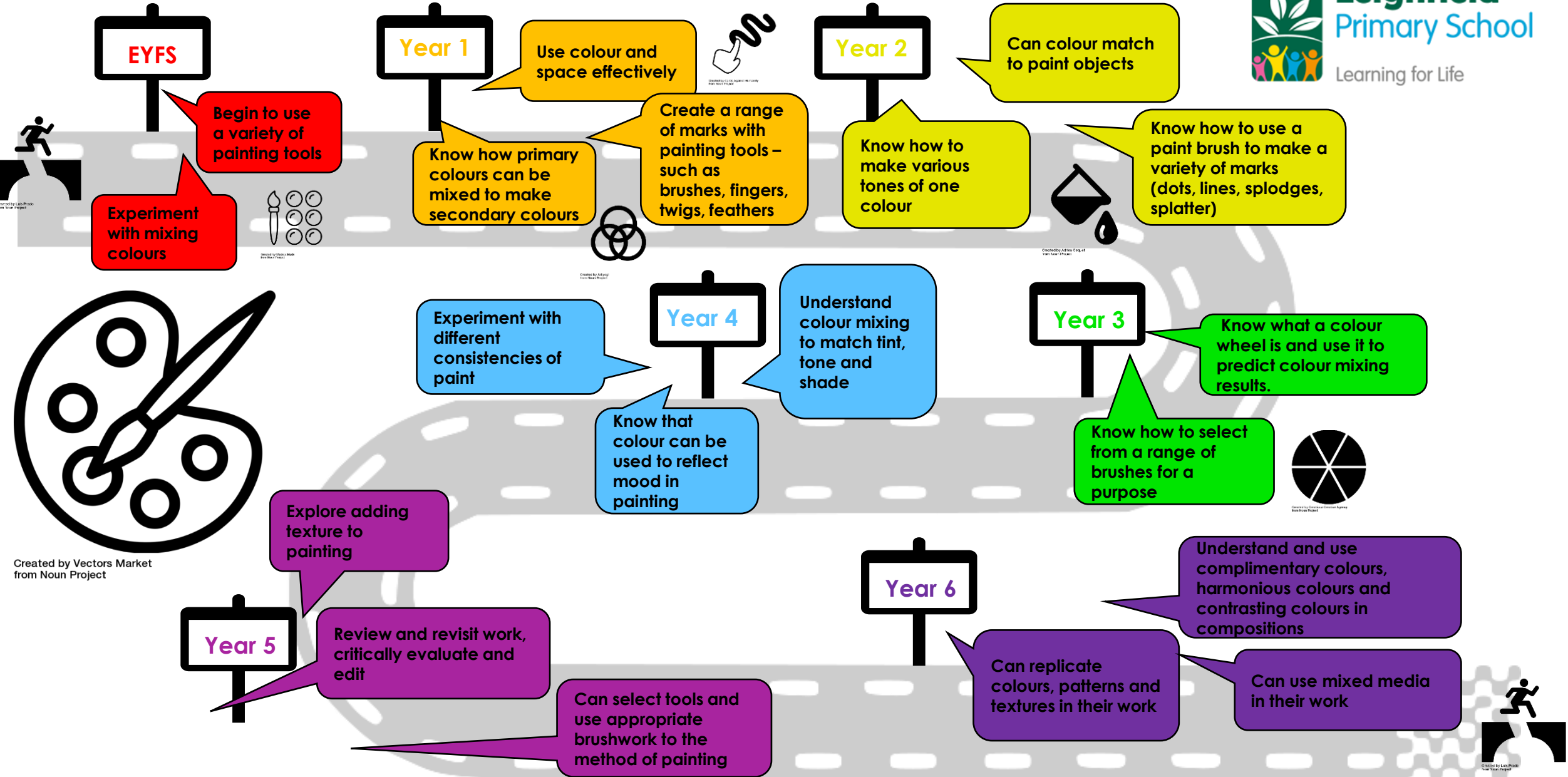

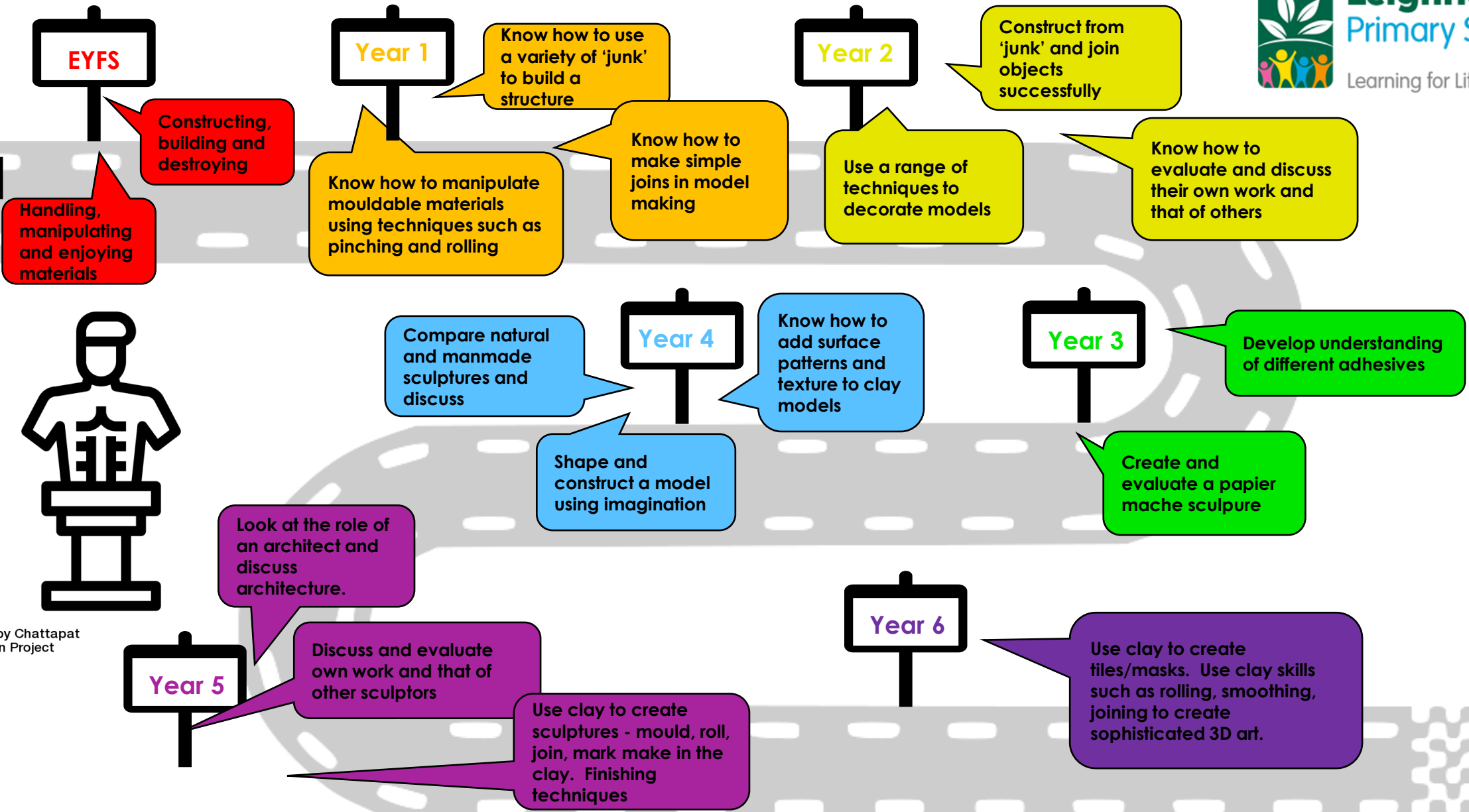
# Art Curriculum Coverage Map- Painting (poster paint, watercolour, acrylic, ink)

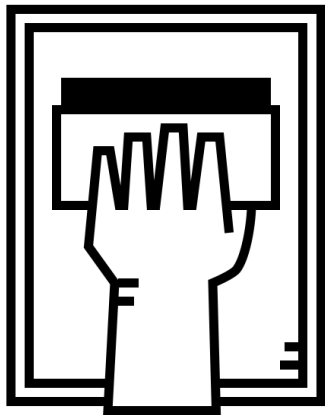
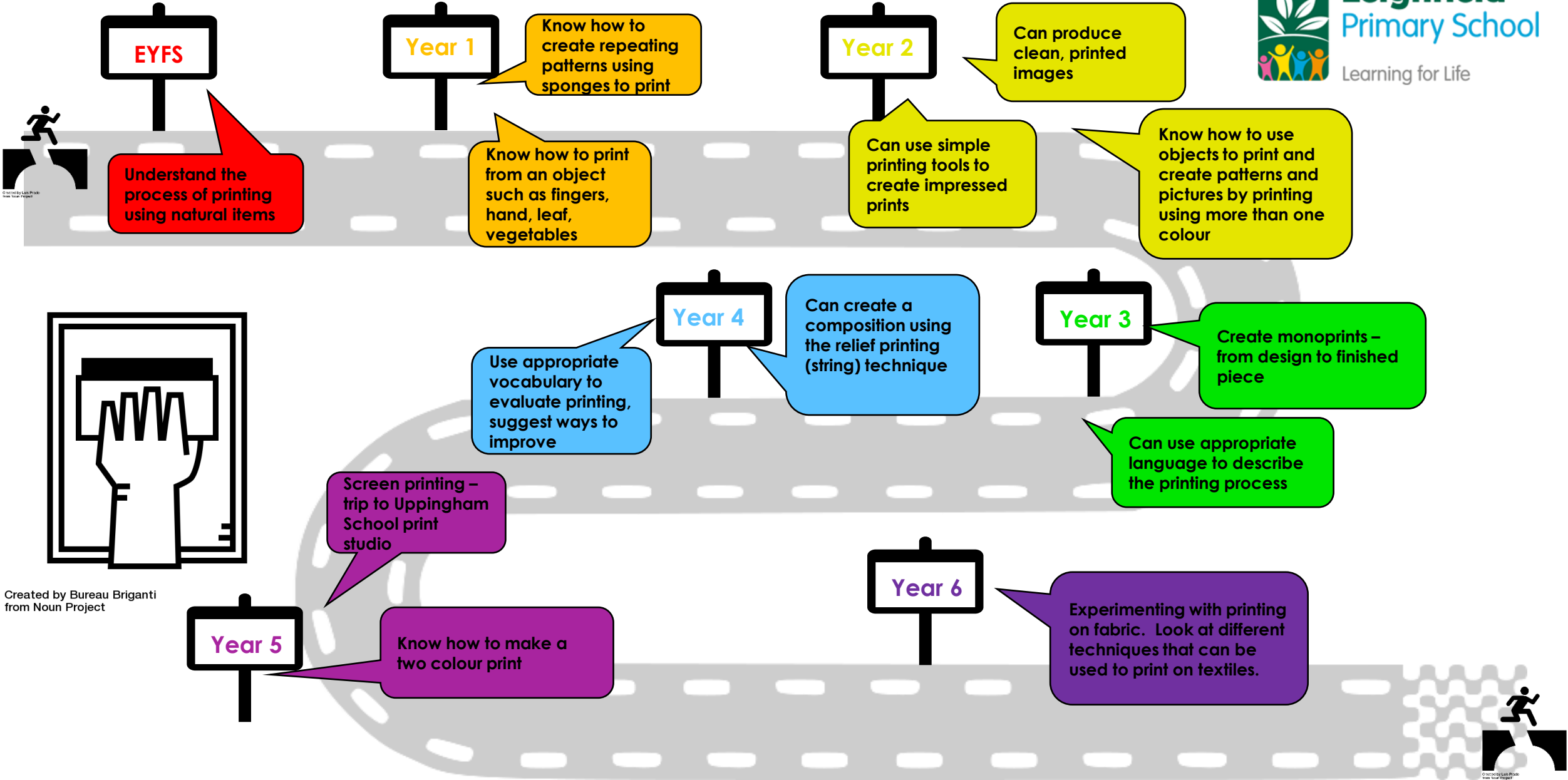
# Art Curriculum Coverage Map – 3D

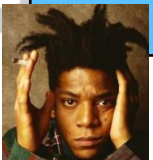

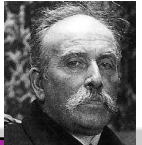
